The Carnduff Centennial Community Fund Inc. was established in 2007. This community fund serves Carnduff and area working to enhance the future of our area through arts, culture, entertainment and sport.

What is a Community Fund?

A community fund is a locally ran organization that builds and manages endowment funds to support charitable activities in the area. Community funds allow individuals to become part of community development having their investment dollars put to work to benefit the community.

The Carnduff Centennial Community Fund allows individuals to invest in our community, to become part of ensuring that there is a lasting investment that can be used to “Enhance Our Future” through arts, culture entertainment and sports projects and initiatives. Many times individuals would like to leave willed or estate contributions to their community which served them but are unsure how to do this. Now through the Carnduff Centennial Community Fund Inc. individuals have the option to do just that, invest back into their community that invested in them!

How the Community Fund Began?

The Carnduff Centennial Community Fund Inc. began following the success of the Carnduff Centennial Celebration in 2005. It was the wish of the Carnduff Centennial organizing committee to see the proceeds from the celebration preserved and built upon. Thus was born the Carnduff Centennial Community Fund Inc. The short-term goal of the Carnduff Centennial Community Fund is to grow the fund to an amount that will generate enough interest to allow for investment back into the community through arts, culture, entertainment and sport initiatives or projects. Once a sizeable amount of investment has been acquired, the interest from the investment will be made available for investment back into the community.

Our Community Fund

The Carnduff Centennial Community Fund Inc. is comprised of six members with the following representation: two members at large that were a part of the 2005 Centennial Committee, two members from the Town of Carnduff Council, one member from the R.M. of Mount Pleasant No. 2 Council and one member from the recreation board. This committee will be responsible for awarding the funds to the successful applicants.

At such time when the interest will be invested back into the community there will be an application process for the funds. This process will be completed twice yearly with each deadline well advertised. Applications will be available to those interested and must meet the following criteria (one or more criteria may be waived at the discretion of the committee). The project or initiative must be beneficial to the community, must be a lasting project, there is to be a matching financial contribution, costs to be determined (other sources of funds available), project to be commenced within six months of approval and completed within one year unless an extension is granted and a specific description of project.
